LED headlights have never been approved by NHTSA. All LED headlights are illegal, but NHTSA just sits there, doing nothing. Ralph Nader pushed Congress to create the law called the Motor Vehicle Safety Act of 1966 that is supposed to prevent automakers from making cars that put us at risk of injury or death. It was the 1966 Chevrolet Corvair that inspired Ralph Nader to write his book Unsafe at Any Speed. Now the auto industry is at it again with blinding LED headlights.
