The Motor Vehicle Safety Act of 1966 holds the automaker accountable for design flaws that put the public at risk of injury or death. LED headlights are such a design flaw because LED light beams decrease driver vision and LED headlights do not comply with FMVSS-108. The Motor Vehicle Safety Act provides that the auto maker must either provide a fix (in this case, a halogen headlight) or reimburse the consumer for the price of their vehicle.
