Dear Mr. Baker:

On August 5, 2022, August 11, 2022, and September 9, 2022, The Soft Lights Foundation submitted petitions under 49 C.F.R Part 552 requesting that NHTSA issue orders stating MY 2021 Tesla Model 3, MY 2021 Ford Bronco, and MY 2022 Rivian R1T motor vehicles do not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 108, *Lamp, Reflective Devices, and Associated Equipment*.

This letter is to acknowledge the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's (NHTSA's) receipt of the petitions on August 15, 2022, August 18, 2022, and September 9, 2022. NHTSA will conduct a review of the petitions and will determine whether to grant or deny the petitions. If a petition is granted, OVSC will open an investigation to determine whether there is a noncompliance with FMVSS No. 108. Regardless of whether the petitions are granted or denied, you will be notified of NHTSA's decision on the disposition of the above-referenced petitions.
