Dear Mr. Baker:

The above-entitled document dated June 28, 2022, you tendered for filing as a complaint before the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) is being rejected because it fails to specify a violation of any law or any order or rule of the Commission by a public utility.

Rule 4.1(a)(1) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure requires a complaint to set forth, "any act or thing done or omitted to be done by any public utility including any rule or charge heretofore established or fixed by or for any public utility, in violation, or claimed to be in violation, of any provision of law or of any order or rule of the Commission."

In addition, to the extent you intended to file a motion rather than a complaint, pursuant to Rule 11.1 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, a motion cannot be used to initiate a new proceeding but may only be filed in an already open proceeding.
