Re: Soft Lights Foundation v. City of Philadelphia

Dear Mr. Baker:

This letter is in response to your complaint to the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General, Civil Rights Enforcement Section (CRES), received on September 14, 2023, regarding the planned installation of LED lights throughout the city of Philadelphia.

Thank you for bringing this matter to our attention. However, given the nature of your complaint, this is not a matter over which CRES will exercise its investigative authority. We recommend that you file your complaint with the U.S. Department of Justice – in particular, the Civil Rights Division. This division within the U.S. Department of Justice may be better able to address your concerns since it has jurisdiction over alleged violations of Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act.
