Re: Executive Order – Regulation of LED Products

Dear President Biden,

Congress passed the Radiation Control for Health and Safety Act in 1968 to ensure the protection of all citizens from the harms of electromagnetic radiation. The US Food and Drug is mandated, as per 21 U.S.C. 360hh – 360ss, to publish performance standards to ensure the comfort, health, safety, and civil rights of all citizens. Despite having had over 50 years to publish these performance standards for products using Light Emitting Diodes, the FDA has failed to comply with these statutes.

21 U.S.C. 360ii directs the FDA to collaborate with all other federal agencies, including the DOT, NHTSA, FMCSA, FHWA, EPA, CPSC, FAA, OSHA, Access Board, NIST, and others to develop the performance standards for LED products, including LED vehicle headlights, LED street lights, LED light bulbs, LED flashing lights on emergency vehicles, LED indicator lights in appliances, LED lights on towers, LED office lights, LED flashlights, LED bicycle lights, and even LED lights on children's shoes. The FDA has refused to liaise with any of these federal agencies, despite citizen petition FDA-2022-P-1151 which was submitted on June 13, 2022.

As President, you have issued many executive orders to protect public health, protect the environment, and protect civil rights. Because the FDA is unwilling to comply with existing federal law as passed by Congress, it appears that the only way to compel the FDA to comply with the law is for you to issue an executive order directing HHS Secretary Xavier Becerra to comply with 21 U.S.C. 360ii and to contact all federal agencies for the purpose of developing protective performance standards for LED products.

Thus, the Soft Lights Foundation requests that you issue an Executive Order directing HHS and all federal agencies to comply with 21 U.S.C. 360hh – 360ss, publish performance standards for LED products, and notify Congress of the hazards of LED visible radiation.
