

As our population ages, eyesight is a concern. These horrible bright lights are blinding and older eyes don't react as quickly as they once did. There is no reason for them.











These headlights are downright dangerous







They,distract and lose my full attention. On the road in front of me, when in darkness you need more attention driving . I would estimate that it,possibly only 25%,with the blue,light beams.


