	"LED bulbs are greatly cost-effective but the bulbs used for headlights need to be
	regulated. LEDs vary significantly depending on the wavelengths they emit. I have not
	tested any headlights from newer cars, but I would guess based on the pain I feel in my
	eyes that they are predominantly emitting blue light, which is very harmful for our eyes.
	There should be a limit on how much radiometric power is being emitted by headlights and
	high beams vs regular lights should not be a slight angle adjustment. Being slightly down
